
## Powerbuilder version 2022 build 1900




PowerServer Auto build [PBAutoBuild220.exe] not packaging Cloud App Launcher files in the Zip file

## Steps:

- 1. Create test application
- 2. Added PowerServer Build file and created the build.
- 3. Build successfully created without any error



4. Zip file contains the following files



- 5. Export the Build file (.json)
- 6. Create the same application build using PBAutoBuild220 with exported build Json file

## "C:\Program Files (x86)\Appeon\PowerBuilder 22.0\PBAutoBuild220.exe" /f app1\_cprj.json /l powerserver\_app1\_deploy.log /le powerserver\_app1\_error.log /lu powerserver\_app1\_unsupport.log

7. Successful build creation without any error.

Note: Build files will have only runtime libraries and not included Cloud App Install 22.0 files.
